

DISCIPLESHIP TRIANGLES GROUP COVENANT

Our discipleship triangles give us the opportunity to grow loving, mature and equipped disciples of Jesus Christ who impact the family, the church and the community for the sake of global transformation. Discipleship requires commitment. This covenant outlines the commitments we believe need to be made to create and maintain a healthy D-Triangle.

1. COMMITMENT: I will make D triangle meetings a priority and try to be flexible and consistent so we can meet together regularly. (Heb 10:24-25)
2. LOVE: I will try to help my group love God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. I will try to love my group members as I would like them to love me. (Mark 12:30-31)
3. PUT OTHERS FIRST: I will try to consider the other group members more important than myself by praying for them and making myself and my resources available to them. (Phil 2:3-4)
4. SHOWING HONOR: I will try to honor the other members of my group by listening to them and not interrupting, seeking to understand before being understood, letting love be genuine, being honest, and speaking the truth in love. (Rom 12:10)
5. CONFIDENTIALITY: I will not divulge information shared in confidence, with anyone outside this group unless required to by law. I will not push anyone to share information that they would prefer to keep undisclosed. (proverbs 17:9)
